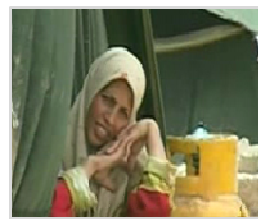




The Refugee Crisis in Iraq & The migration of Iraqi refugees to other countries since 2003



The United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) estimates the number of Iraqis who migrated after the occupation of this country and its sectarian violence at 4.4 million people, of which 2.2 million migrated into neighboring countries such as Syria, Jordan and Egypt. The other 2.2 million migrated inside Iraq. These stark figures tell us that one out of every eight Iraqis is homeless and many of them live in severe poverty.
